Gentlemen:

A most peculiar point has been brought up by one of our employees. We know, of course, who you people are; in fact, in the Ethyl Clinic that was held here in La Crosse last fall for about five weeks we were instrumental in bringing it here and we believe that one of the reasons you had such good attendance was our assistance and help.

All this is preliminary to the fact that what we are going to write you we can hardly believe it, we do not know why, and we think it is entirely something else other than what one of our employees thinks.

In our shops we do valve grinding and motor work for the dealers and garagemen in this vicinity. We have one man who specializes in this work. The motors come to us dis-assembled. He has to clean all the accumulation of carbon or what-have-you from the heads, from the valves and the valve guides by means of wire brushes or scrapers before he can go ahead with the valve work. During the process of this work there is dust that the high speed wire brushes take off the valves and off the heads. It floats in the air. This employee has been complaining that when he has an especially heavy day the lead from the Ethyl that floats in this dust gets into his mouth, lungs and stomach; it destroys his appetite and gives him a terrible headache. In fact, he is of the opinion that it must be lead because it tastes sweet in his mouth. We might say that the shop where he works is very well ventilated, with absolutely no exhaust fumes from motors or anything whatsoever.

We would appreciate your thoughts, ideas, or if you have ever had this type of complaint before.
