

1 on file in the materials analysis laboratory of both
2 experimental and production samples of Kaylo
3 indicating that there is asbestos remaining in the
4 product after autoclaving.

5 What it is, Dr. Cohen is our X-ray
6 diffraction specialist who was there in the '50s, '60s
7 and '70s.

8 And he had on file -- paperwork like this on
9 file where he had analyzed Kaylo back in the '50s and
10 '60s on file, and that is what he is referring to, the
11 patterns that he had run on those products back at
12 that time.

13 Q Is he referring to the asbestos-free Kaylo
14 or the old Kaylo?

15 A He is referring to the old Kaylo that
16 contained asbestos.

17 Q Mr. Helser, just a few last questions.

18 What is your current position now at
19 Owens-Corning?

20 A I am an advanced scientist at the technical
21 center in Granville.
