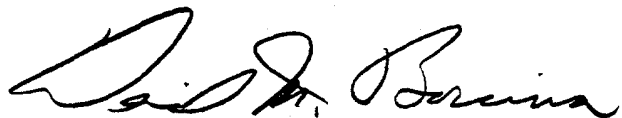
The Board also approved the following 1971 assessment rates applicable to all members:

| <u>Classification</u>  | <u>1971 Rates Per Ton</u> |
|------------------------|---------------------------|
| Mining                 | \$.17                     |
| Smelting & Refining    | .07                       |
| Manufacturing          | .07                       |
| Assembled Articles     | .04                       |
| Pig Lead Sales in U.S. | .84                       |

The 1971 rate per ton represents a decrease of approximately 20 percent under the 1970 assessment rate.
