The group set Saturday, Oct 10, as the time for the Box-Lunch Social, followed by folk dancing and entertainment, at the Berryessa School.

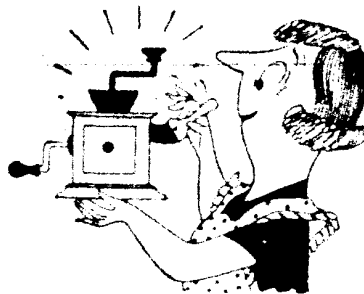
