In March, 1929, I sent you a revised manuscript of a proposed Sarason Laboratory report entitled "Asbestos in Pneumonia". I informed you that Sarason proposed to arrange for its publication "as promptly as possible". After unsuccessful efforts on our part to hasten its publication date, it finally appeared in the January, 1931 issue of "A.E.S. Archives of Industrial Hygiene and Occupational Medicine" where it bears the title "EXPERIMENTAL STUDIES ON ASBESTOSIS". A reprint is enclosed. I have no additional copies but others can doubtless be obtained from the magazine.

I assume we can now write final on the experimental program initiated as a joint project by the asbestos textile industry nearly fifteen years ago. Despite many delays and attendant disappointments, I believe we are entitled to conclude that the project was worth while.
