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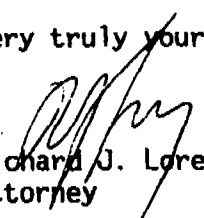
Dear Sir or Madam:

All of your companies have been sued in the Wanda Gail Cox lawsuit filed in the U.S. District Court for the District of South Carolina alleging that they supplied pvc to Stauffer Chemical Company from 1978 through 1982 and 1985 through 1986.
