This new Combination Lead Bend and Brass Ferrule has a number of distinct advantages.

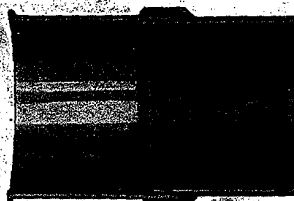
First, it is a money-saver because it can be purchased at a price lower than what you now pay for the lead bend and the brass ferrule separately and joining the two together. It also takes some of the uncertainty out of estimating, for the cost of each outlet is the same.

Second, it is a time-saver because it comes to you as a complete unit...no joint to wipe. It can be installed more quickly and, therefore, a greater number of outlets can be put in place in a day.

Third, it is a better type of outlet as may be seen in cross-section illustration. The joint is smooth on the inner face and lapped in the direction of the flow. There are no beads of solder to interfere with the free passage of water...no places for solid waste matter to collect. The joint, moreover, is doubly strong because it is reinforced, or bonded, inside as well as outside. Under test of 100 pounds water pressure, this double-bonded joint withstood the strain without the slightest sign of failure.

We also manufacture a straight-piece Combination Lead and Brass Ferrule which has the same double-bonded joint and which gives the same time-saving and money-saving advantages.

Both articles are made in 4", 8 lb. lead and the heavy ferrule is of high quality brass.

**New Outside Diameters**

National Lead Company's lead pipe now comes in new, increased outside diameters in all sizes from 1 1/4" to 2" inclusive. These new diameters conform to recommendation of the Lead Industries Association, and will safely withstand constant, cold water pressures as follows:

	Per Sq. In.
A, or Strong	50 lbs.
AA, or Extra Strong	75 lbs.
AAA, or Double Extra Strong	100 lbs.

This familiar trade-mark is your assurance of lead pipe of high quality, proper wall thickness and correct weight per running foot. National Lead pipe is marked every few inches with the Dutch Boy trade-mark and the name of the National Lead Company.
