MINUTES IN TRANSIT

FULL-RATE	DAY LETTER

IN COMMENTING ON NRA SUPREME COURT DECISION THE PRESIDENT HAS URGED CODED INDUSTRIES TO CONTINUE TO COOPERATE IN THE OBSERVANCE OF CODE PROVISIONS RELATING TO HOURS AND WAGES AND STANDARDS OF FAIR COMPETITION STOP AS CHAIRMAN OF THE CODE AUTHORITY I AM PERSONALLY OF THE OPINION THAT THIS IS THE WISE COURSE TO PURSUE FOR THE REASON THAT I AM INCLINED TO BELIEVE THAT CONGRESS WILL ENACT SOME LEGISLATION THAT WILL PERMIT INDUSTRY TO COOPERATE WITHIN THE SCOPE OF THE RECENT SUPREME COURT RULING STOP IN THE NEAR FUTURE A MEETING OF THE CODE AUTHORITY WILL BE CALLED AND SHORTLY THEREAFTER INDUSTRY MEETINGS BY THE SUBCODE AUTHORITIES WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE HELD AT WHICH TIME PLANS FOR THE FUTURE WILL BE FINALLY DECIDED STOP IF INDUSTRY TAKES IMPROPER ADVANTAGE OF THIS INTERIM PERIOD IT WILL SUPPLY ADEQUATE AMMUNITION TO THOSE WHO BELIEVE THAT INDUSTRY MUST BE REGIMENTED AND WILL UNDOUBTEDLY BE THE CAUSE OF MANY LABOR DISTURBANCES STOP IT IS MY PERSONAL RECOMMENDATION THAT PENDING CONSIDERATION BY CONGRESS OF THE WHOLE SITUATION MEMBERS OF THE INDUSTRY SHOULD EXPRESS THEIR INTENTION TO VOLUNTARILY CONTINUE THE

OBSERVANCE OF ARTICLES 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 AND TEN OF THE CODE OF FAIR COMPETITION FOR THIS INDUSTRY STOP IF IT IS THE DECISION OF YOUR COMPANY TO CONTINUE SUCH OBSERVANCE OF THE CODE IT IS SUGGESTED THAT YOU TELEGRAPH THE SECRETARY OF THE SUBDIVISION AS FOLLOWS STOP QUOTE THIS IS TO ADVISE THAT UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE THIS COMPANY HAS VOLUNTARILY DECIDED TO CONTINUE TO OBSERVE ARTICLES 3, 4, 5, 7, 8 AND TEN OF THE CODE OF FAIR COMPETITION OF THE ASBESTOS INDUSTRY AS CONTRACT OBLIGATIONS VOLUNTARILY ASSUMED WHEN IT SIGNED THE CODE AND HEREBY REQUEST THE SUBCODE AUTHORITY AND THE CODE AUTHORITY TO CONTINUE TO FUNCTION AS MAY BE REQUIRED FOR SUCH PURPOSES PENDING INDUSTRY MEETINGS AND FINAL COLLECTIVE ACTION UNQUOTE STOP THIS TELEGRAM IS BEING SENT TO ALL MEMBERS OF EACH SUBDIVISION OF THE INDUSTRY AND REPLIES THERETO WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO ALL MEMBERS OF EACH SUBDIVISION=
