Caution
Contains Asbestos Fibre
Avoid Creating Dust
Breathing Asbestos Dust May Cause
Serious Bodily Harm

This label has been prescribed for use by the United States Department of Labor, Occupational Safety and Health Administration pursuant to 29 C.F.R. Section 1910.1001. It was promulgated in 1972. Prior to that time and commencing in January 1970, ACL labeled bags of raw asbestos fibre with the notice:

Caution - This bag contains chrysotile asbestos fibre. Persons exposed to this material should use adequate protective devices as inhalation of this material over long periods may be harmful.

In 1980, the following wording was put on the bags:

WARNING
Contains Asbestos Fibres
Avoid Creating Dust
Breathing Asbestos Dust May Cause Cancer
And Other Fatal Diseases
Smoking Greatly Increases The
Lung Cancer Risk
