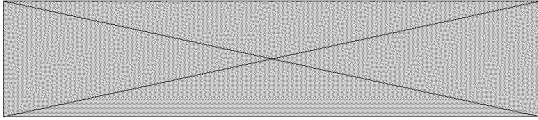

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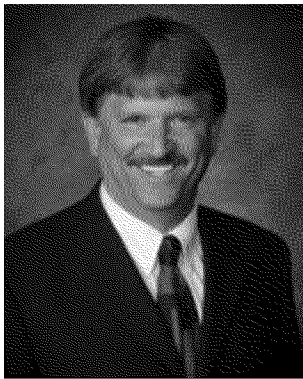

We hope this site visit will be one of the top priorities for Administrator Pruitt's schedule when he travels to Alabama in the Fall.

Some of the key points for Plant Miller that I think Administrator Pruitt would find noteworthy include:

1. It is among the most productive coal plants in America
2. Invested \$1.6B in major environmental enhancements to comply with EPA regs
3. Significant economic and philanthropic boost for local communities

PLANT MILLER

HISTORY

- * Construction began in 1973
- * The four units went into commercial production between 1978 and 1991

CAPACITY/ GENERATION

- * 2,916 MWs of capacity
- * 18,193,039 MWhs of net generation in 2016
- * Produces enough energy to serve about 1 million homes
- * In 2013 and 2015 ranked first among our nation's coal plants in net generation
- * World class availability when compared to peers

FUEL

- * Economically priced low-sulfur Powder River Basin coal
- * Approximately 10 million tons burned annually
- * 650 train loads per year

ENVIRONMENTAL ENHANCEMENTS

- * Invested \$1.6 billion in environmental controls to comply with EPA regulations

 - Electrostatic precipitators
