SUBSCRIPTIONS - 1958

To Members of the Lead Industries Association:

The attached statement is an estimate of your Company's subscriptions to the Lead Industries Association for the first quarter of 1958. Adjustments will be made later in the year when complete 1957 production and consumption figures from members are available.

For the Ordinary and Health and Safety Funds, member's subscriptions, except those on a minimum basis, are increased 15 per cent over the last quarter of 1957 to approximate the increase in the budget for these Funds.

For the Industry Development Fund subscriptions for the first quarter of 1958 have been increased 80 per cent compared with the last quarter of 1957 to approximate the larger budget approved for this Fund.

Details of the approved budgets for 1958 are attached.

SUBSEQUENT ADJUSTMENTS

In order that we may make adjustments in a subsequent statement based upon the final 1957 tonnages reported by members, won't you send us, at your earliest convenience, your tonnages for the year 1957 on:

1. Domestic lead mined (recoverable lead content only).
2. Lead melted and refined.
3. Lead consumed in manufacture of lead products.
4. Lead consumed in manufacture of assembled articles (such as storage batteries, cable and ammunition).
5. Foreign lead exported to the United States (including ores, concentrates, bullion, pig lead, and lead products - lead content only).
6. Pig lead sold in the United States.
