One of our clients is interested in acquiring a parcel of vacant, isolated, Park Lands located just north of Forte Foote Park, below National Harbor, Maryland through a land exchange. Attached is large overview map with the property circled in red, along with a Boundary Exhibit.

The National Park Service acquired the land in 1964 for the purpose of building a George Washington Parkway on the Maryland side of the Potomac. Today, the park land sits behind a neighborhood development, to our knowledge has no egress or ingress, and is essentially abandoned.

We were wondering if we could come meet with you or your staff to discuss the possibility of acquiring this land through exchange, identify potential lands for the Park Service to acquire, as well as to go over certain caveats about parcel's title.
