This letter is in response to the Agency request for additional information concerning the above referenced test mixture.

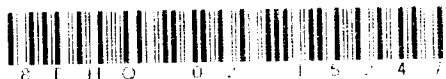
The tested mixture is the active ingredient in Zonyl® FSP Fluorosurfactant. It is used to impart wetting and leveling properties in institutional, industrial and household cleaning products such as floor polish and latex paint formulations in the range of one-hundred to five-hundred parts per million.

DuPont has conducted extensive studies to be able to define safe use and handling for our customers.
