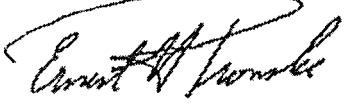
RE: EPA Proposed Ban Of Asbestos-Cement Pipe

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) recently announced that it will propose legislation banning the manufacture and sale of asbestos-cement (AC) pipe and fittings.

The AC Pipe Producers Association (ACEPA), of which J-M is a member, has written a position paper on asbestos-cement pipe (see attachment Industry Response To EPA Proposed Rulemaking), and we fully support the contents.

In addition:

"J-M believes that asbestos/cement water pipe is a proven product for use in potable water systems. We are unaware that the use of the pipe has resulted in any adverse medical conditions. Our plants meet OSHA standards for clean air and we plan to manufacture the product as long as there is viable market or unless we are legislated out of business."
