The meeting was called to order at 9:15 A.M.

BUDGET FOR 1956

The secretary presented for consideration the budget recommendations for 1956, which had been circulated to members of the committee on November 16, 1955.

It was regularly moved, seconded and carried, that the recommended transfers from the Industry Development Fund of \$23,000 and \$9,500 to the Metallic Lead Products Division Fund and the Pigments and Chemicals Division Fund respectively, be made.

It was also regularly moved, seconded and carried that \$1,500 from the Industry Development Fund be used, together with a like amount from the Ordinary Fund as in the past, to place the publication, LEAD, on a quarterly basis rather than a semi-annual basis.



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It was recognized that no further appropriation or action can be taken on the lead radiation shielding program at this time but must await the receipt of the report from Walter Kilde Nuclear Laboratories, approved at a previous meeting.

No action was taken on the Ceramic Fund as appropriations for this Fund to the end of 1955 had been previously approved.

The secretary further suggested that the committee might, at some future time, consider the production of one or more motion pictures on the uses of lead, no such pictures being available at the present time. It was suggested that the Association staff might outline something along this line for future consideration.

Meeting adjourned at 10:15 A.M.
