If this meets with your approval, please so indicate by signing the enclosed copy of this letter and returning it to me for our files.

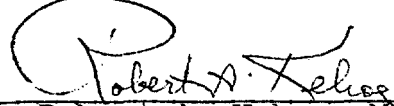
