

① Construction began in early 1951 on a Vinyl Chloride unit and was completed in the latter part of 1952. The first tank car of VCM was shipped from our plant on October 24, 1952. This unit was shut down in December of 1968 and dismantled. Dismantling was completed March 1969.

In Dec 1971 we completed construction and started operation of an ethylene Vinyl Chloride unit. This unit uses VCM as a raw material. It is shipped into our plant in closed containers under pressure. It goes

directly into the process from the closed containers with no one's eyes being exposed to it.

② Present plant work force exclusive of secretarial and office personnel is 966. (May 31, 1973).

③ a) At the time our VCM unit was operating there were thirty one operators in the unit. Supervision in the unit at the beginning was approximately 12, but later reduced to approximately six. Samples of material were run in our quality control lab by an analytical

group which numbered at that
time approximately 50 (3/31/53) employees.

Product was shipped out of
the plant by our Material Handling
Group which numbered approximately
24 (3/31/53) at that time.

Plant maintenance was handled at that
time by a maintenance force of approximately
355 (3/31/53). Most of these employees, at
some time during the year, would be
assigned to this unit, ^{for short periods} either during the
normal work hours or during overtime.

b) Our present EVC plant is staffed with 15 operators and six supervisory personnel.

Quality control samples are handled by our laboratory with a staff of approximately 29 employees.

Our Material handling group at this time includes approximately 44 employees.

Our plant maint work force is approximately 308 at this time.
