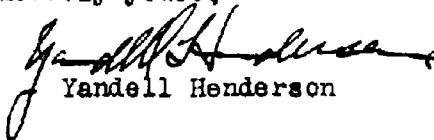
Dear Doctor Cumming:

May I call your attention to the fact that on February 2nd, the New York Public Health Council took action which virtually approves the distribution of tetra ethyl lead to refineries and filling stations, and virtually authorizes the sale of ethyl gas to the public.

All present conditions seem to me to render it imperative that the commission to investigate this matter should be appointed at the earliest possible date.
