Dear Doctor Edwards:

A report of the analytical results of the samples submitted by you will be forthcoming very soon by Dr. Robert A. Kehoe, Director of the Kettering Laboratory.

I have discussed with him the proposed plans for a hygienic survey as outlined during my recent visit, and requested by you according to the inter-office memorandum of November 7, 1949, concerning a "Study on Lead Research." He is very favorably disposed toward this project, and regards it as an excellent opportunity to obtain basic information with respect to the hygienic aspects of the use of aviation fuels and repair and maintenance operations on airplane motors. Dr. Kehoe expects to be in Miami sometime during the early part of January and will discuss with you further various aspects of this problem. Meanwhile it will be very helpful if you would send me a job analysis sheet of the various activities as listed in your memorandum so that I can set up the industrial history sheet to include occupational details that will be very important in a survey of this type.

I wish to express my appreciation of your hospitable influence during my visit and of the cooperative interest of you and your associates.
