Also, note on the subject tariff that item 1790 on page 104 & 105 is the item to be used to obtain these new rates. Please include "Bill under Item 1790" and "Paint" or "Paint Materials" somewhere on the bill of lading. This does not, of course, preclude the D.O.T. description already on the bill of lading.

There is a disparity between rates as evidenced on page 112 "Chicago to Front Royal 413 (42M) as opposed to page 104 "Chicago to Front Royal 371 (42M). Ed Forsha is having this corrected.
