Dear Mr. Bell:

I have worked up the deposition in accordance with the instructions in your letter of November 28th, and it is ready for dispatch to the Workmen's Compensation Board. However, there is one item in your instructions about which I have some question so that I am inquiring about it before sending the deposition. In your question No.23, you state that you are handing me a carbon copy of the testimony, and further down in the question you request me to file a copy of the transcript as "Exhibit 2" in connection with my deposition. On the other hand, in your letter of November 28th you say that you are sending me your office copy of the testimony and that I should return it to you. Obviously I can not do both, and it appears to me that some substantial proof should be submitted to the Industrial Board that I have actually seen the certified testimony. I have no copy of the testimony except your desk copy and I wonder, therefore, what I should do in this dilemma. Please drop me a line by return mail and send me either additional copy of the testimony or instructions as to what to do about "Exhibit 2".
