

Excerpt from letter, June 13, 1949
Harry J. Fisher to Manfred Dowditch

"As regards the amounts of lithopone in our crayons, our analysis showed 8.56 barium sulphate and 2.54 per cent zinc sulphide in an orange crayon and 18.80 per cent of BaSO_4 and 3.46 per cent of ZnS in a yellow-orange crayon. We have no precise information on the weight of the crayons consumed by the child."
