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Copied from By-Laws and Trade Rules of Carpenters and Joiners
Local Union No. 14 -- San Antonio, Texas

Article XI, Section 6.

"All laying of creosoted shingles or handling of
creosoted timbers, freshly painted materials, the application
of cork in hot tar or asphalt, and the placing of all rock
wool and fibre glass whether nailed, tacked, blown in place
or placed in any other manner shall be paid for at the rate
of $12\frac{1}{2}$ cents above the regular rate for journeyman carpenters."

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
