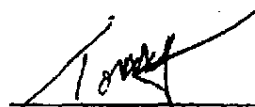

Please find attached an industry-sponsored study on the effects of exposure to vinyl chloride.

This study concludes that worker exposure to vinyl chloride at several hundred ppm for periods of greater than 15 years has caused angiosarcoma. However, there is no evidence that exposure to vinyl chloride has caused any other disease.
