To: U. S. and Canadian Members of the LIA Health and Safety Committee

Re: November 14, 1966 meeting of the Pennsylvania Air Pollution Commission

At this meeting the Commission accepted the report of its Technical Subcommittee recommending, among other things, an ambient air quality criterion for lead of 5 micrograms per cubic meter of air averaged over a 30-day period. The vote on acceptance was that the report was "received for public bearing." No date for a public hearing was set, and we do not expect a date for such a hearing to be set until the time of the next Commission meeting, which is scheduled for December 27.

We recommend that the interested parties in the lead industry meet with us here in New York on Friday, December 9th, for further discussion of the Pennsylvania situation. As soon as possible we will send further details about this meeting.
