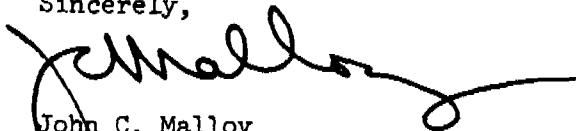
The registration fee will be \$20.00, covering luncheon and meeting expenses, which may be paid by check to SPI with your pre-registration, or at the door.
