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REICHHARD RESIGNS

Leonard G. Reichhard has resigned as production manager of National Lead Company to accept a position with another company.

Mr. Reichhard's resignation terminates an association that began in 1916 shortly before he graduated from Columbia University. He was made production manager in 1938 and became a director of the Company, as well as a member of the Executive Committee, in January of this year.

SHIRLEY NEW PRODUCTION MANAGER
