11 in teaching.

12 I returned to the University of Kansas in
13 1967 as assistant professor and promoted to associate
14 professor in 1971 and been full professor in 1976.

15 Q So you actually teach medical students?

16 A Teach medical students, interns, residents
17 and fellows specializing in pulmonary and critical
18 care medicine.

19 Q You belong to any organizations at all?

20 A A lot of organizations. State and county
21 medical societies, the American College of Physicians,
