It was a pleasure to meet you at the event this morning organized by Grayling.

I wanted to ask if you would have time for a short meeting with DIGITALEUROPE to talk further about the REACH revision and PFAS restriction.

Our members support the ambition to phase out the use of PFAS in electronic products wherever possible in a timely manner and are currently in the process of gathering technical information and investigating alternatives together with their supply chain partners. We are aware that the dossier is currently being examined by the ECHA Committees but consider that it would be valuable to have an exchange with you at this stage of the process.

The Chair of our Chemicals working group and PFAS-lead from Canon will be in Brussels on 14 July, and it would be a great to take this opportunity to have a short meeting with you. We will have a meeting with and his colleagues from DG GROW 11.00-12.00 but are otherwise flexible.

If that day does not work for you, I would be happy to organize a meeting at a more suitable date.
