Dear Dr. Kehoe:

*Gloves in my laboratory in Lab. 2000.
See letter about them*

We are sending you under separate cover a pair of Neoprene gloves which have been forwarded us by our Los Angeles office. The Carter-Lockard Company, distributors for Davis equipment in California wrote us a letter and asked if we could approve these for our type of work.

From the standpoint of doing mechanical work with gloves on, we find that a very thin type is much preferable to the heavy rubber, or even these neoprene gloves. It is almost impossible to start a nut on a thread or hold small pieces of material with gloves so thick as it is difficult to flex the fingers.

Since they have specifically asked for a report on them, I wonder if you would be good enough to let us have your comments.
