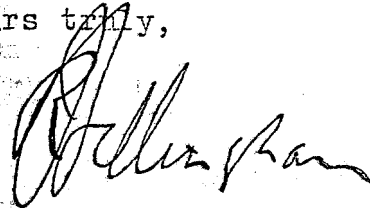

We have a rather full history of the symptoms and I have gone over them with Dr. Morton, and it is not conceivable that Ethyl entered into the matter at all, and I believe that it is not now claimed that Ethyl was a prominent feature. For other reasons we are of the opinion that there is no liability on our part under the Workmen's Compensation Act, and we are denying the claim. If this case develops any features interesting from the Ethyl standpoint, I will keep you advised.
