Under the expanded technical assistance program of the United Nations, the ILO office has sent safety and health and labor inspection experts to Argentina, Burma, Chile, Egypt, Guatemala, Indonesia, Iraq, Iran, Nicaragua, Pakistan, the Philippines, Thailand, and Turkey Under the United Nations Development Program, the ILO has sent safety and health and labour inspection experts to more than 30 countries throughout the world In many cases it has supplied technical equipment for laboratory and demonstration purposes

In cooperation with the Special Fund of the United Nations, ILO has carried out two comprehensive projects, one in the field of mine safety and the other in occupational safety and health linked to productivity techniques These projects have led to the establishment of the Central Mining Research Station at Dhanbad and of three Regional Labour Institutes, also in India

Fellowships under the program have been awarded to safety and health officials in several countries to enable them to study in highly industrialized countries

Originally established as the International Sanitary Bureau in 1902, the Pan American Health Organization serves as the regional office for the World Health Organization for the Americas The purposes of the PAHO are to promote and coordinate the efforts of the countries of the Western Hemisphere to combat disease, lengthen life, and promote the physical and mental health of the people

Programs encompass technical collaboration with governments in the field of public health, including such subjects as sanitary engineering and environmental sanitation, eradication or control of communicable diseases, and maternal and child health

The United States became a member of the World Health Organization on June 21, 1948,

by joint resolution of Congress There are over 125 member nations and 3 associate member nations in WHO

WHO's objective is the attainment by all peoples of the highest possible level of health—physical, mental, and social The organization recognizes health as fundamental to the attainment of peace and security, and as being dependent upon the fullest cooperation of individuals and states

WHO assists countries to strengthen their public health services, including environmental sanitation, mental health, communicable disease control, and health aspects of the peaceful uses of atomic energy Advisory and demonstration teams are sent to countries requesting assistance

Educational Institutions

Many colleges and universities offer formal courses in industrial safety In the following list, compiled by the American Society of Safety Engineers, accredited four-year colleges and universities are grouped by those that offer a degree program with concentration on industrial safety and those that offer one or more credit courses as an elective within engineering or education curricula

The ASSE survey is titled "Safety Courses and Degree Programs Currently Available, July 1968" Over 1250 accredited 4-year colleges and universities across the U S A and Canada were surveyed The list was compiled from information supplied by the 67 respondents (out of 152) who said they offered degree programs and/or credit courses in safety

This survey showed that no clear-cut curriculum in safety has been developed Because of the broad scope, overlap, and interdisciplinary relationships in the field, degree programs (primarily at the Masters level) have been established in engineering and education departments of institutions, mostly as a result of an individual at that institution who saw a need

As a result of the increasing national interest in product, traffic, and occupational safety, it is ASSE's intent to carry out a vigorous role in working with institutions that presently have, who are actively planning, or who are interested in developing such programs
