The Subcommittee on Industrial Hygiene met on November 9, 1962.

Liaison members to the American Standards Association reported on the activities of the Z-62, Z-37 and Z-4 Committees. No significant activities have occurred since the last report.

The subcommittee's report "Industrial Hygiene Aspects of Petroleum Refining Processes" is complete. Mr. E. O. Mattocks has been asked to distribute the report within the membership of the API.

A questionnaire to determine laboratory hood requirements has been prepared and will be distributed to the medical directors of the API. The results will be compiled as a guide to member companies seeking an economic approach to effective hoods.

The chairman reported on the activities of the Asphalt Committee and asked the subcommittee members to aid in obtaining data evaluating environmental exposures to asphalt.

The subcommittee has no items requiring budgetary expenditures.
