Dr. Machle handed me your letter of March 17th with its criticism of the attitude of the medical staff of the Ethyl Gasoline Corporation. I shall reply to the letter which you attached to your own note, but perhaps I should let you know that we usually recommend gin rather than gasoline for the alleviation of the type of pain described in Mr. Young's letter. The usual prescription requires the patient to rub a small quantity of gin on the skin and to drink the remainder of the bottle. Perhaps this knowledge will enable you to reply to such letters in the future.
