Relative to my referenced letter, we now feel that we need to know all we can about our former employees who have had "significant" exposure to our PVC operations. Perhaps we will go after these individuals, rather than await their request.

In individual discussions with Messrs. Adams, Herbig, Barr, Spurlock, and Dr. Kushner, we have interpretations of the meaning of "significant" ranging from one (1) year in our PVC reactor operations to five (5) years in this area.

In order for Mr. Fleming to reach a decision, we have been requested to secure the number of people involved if we use one (1) year in PVC, three (3) years in PVC, or five (5) years in PVC as a "cut off date" to satisfy our interpretation of "significant" exposure.

Please review your records of former employees and advise me of the number of persons in each of the above one (1) year, three (3) years, or five (5) years categories at your earliest opportunity. Also advise the status of examination arrangements for the two former Calvert City employees who have previously requested an examination.
