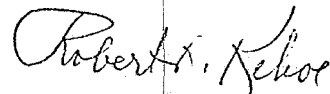
Dear Mr. Cowan:

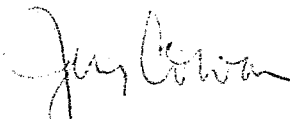

Dear Dr. Gross:

Following our meeting in Cincinnati, our subsequent correspondence and telephone conversations concerning a proposed agreement between you and Dr. Robert A. Kehoe relating to the further development by you of certain human lead balance data accumulated by Dr. Kehoe at the Kettering Laboratory at the University of Cincinnati, and in response to your request that we provide you with some written indication of the mutual intent of you and Dr. Kehoe with respect to the development of the data, I am happy to provide you with the following.

Essentially, it is proposed that you would develop further and publish the results derived from basic data compiled by Dr. Kehoe at the Kettering Laboratory of the University of Cincinnati Department of Environmental Health. The "project", as presently contemplated, would involve three separate phases, and would be completed within two years of the date of commencement of the first phase thereof. The three phases of the project are very generally described as follows:

- Phase 1: Description of and Definition of Data.
- Phase 2: Correction, if possible, of results for dietary variations.
- Phase 3: Development of a mathematical model based on the data with delineation of lead absorption attributable to diet, inhalation, etc.

It is my understanding that Phase 1 will be funded by a grant from the Ethyl Corporation, although I note from your correspondence that Dr. Kehoe has already advanced some \$3,000 toward outside expenses incurred in connection with this aspect of the project.

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undetermined. The balance of the funding would be provided by Dr. Kehoe.

Some, although not all, of the essential provisions of an agreement that occur to me would be:

(1) Any commitment of Dr. Kehoe would be limited to \$30,000, and would be conditioned on your being able to make satisfactory arrangements for funding the balance of the cost of the project.

(2) Designation of some appropriate vehicle for receipt and disbursement of the funds provided by Dr. Kehoe; hopefully this would be accomplished by some form of grant to the university which would be earmarked for this project.

(3) Recognition and credit in all publications of the results of the project of the contributions thereto of Dr. Kehoe and the Kettering Laboratory and/or the Department of Environmental Health of the University of Cincinnati.

(4) If further projects, or further development of the data, are generated by reason of this project, there would be an opportunity for both you and Dr. Kehoe to participate therein.

As I indicated to you over the telephone, it seems to me that preparation of a more formal agreement between you and Dr. Kehoe should await the conclusion of your efforts with respect to establishing the connection with a university or other private organization for providing the additional funding and facilities necessary for the completion of the project.

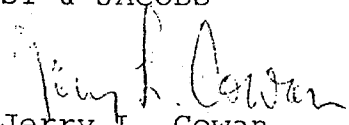
In order, however, to give you the assurance of Dr. Kehoe's interest in the project, as set forth above, I have asked him to review the above and sign it as evidence of his intent to go forward on the basis outlined above.

If this approach is satisfactory, we will simply await further word from you as to the status of your efforts.

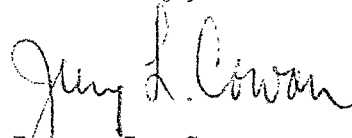
