I appreciate the opportunity to analyze the lung tissues from these three former talc miners. The results of the analyses are summarized in the enclosed abstract. Case 4 in the table refers to Papineau, Case 5 refers to Bracy and Case 6 refers to Gibson. All three of these patients showed marked asbestosis plus talcosis. All three had calcified parietal pleural plaques. And, in addition, Gibson had silicosis.

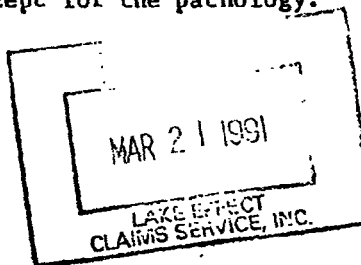
