We have just received our laboratory test report covering the 24,8155 short tons of Blue Fibre received on the steamship "Hough Silvercrest", your invoice ASA-139 dated July 22, 1949.

This report indicates that not only was the rock content found to be 29% but the fibre length was short and thus the fibre structure was low. This is rather disturbing and we desire you to tell us what action you are going to take in this situation.
