Dear Doctor:-

You can do us quite a service if you will answer the question raised in this letter.

We have about three hundred employees here at Dayton, and approximately one-half of them work in our factories and one-half are office people. You have had a lot of experience in the question of industrial hazards and the health of employees. You also by contact with us and by the contacts that your associates have had with our plant are pretty well informed concerning our working conditions here in the manufacture of paint, varnish and lacquer.

What we would like to have is your recommendation as to the kind of a physical examination we should give prospective employees to determine whether or not they might become a hazard if we put them in our organization.

There is no particular hurry about our securing this information but we will appreciate your dropping us a note at your convenience outlining just how much of a physical examination you believe it would be wise for us to require.
