I am not able to send this to you by e-mail as the network server is down.

Our ASBESTOS CONSULTANTS name is Sun City Analytical at 533-8840. Luis Acuna is our company representative. You will need to get with him on Monday, so he can let ERI that you have accepted their bid. He will probably get with you on specifics. He will also put a 10 day notification in for you, usually signed by myself or L. Castor, should there be any changes on the original notification, ie; start-date, waste transporter, etc. Start date submitted to the State was for January 24<sup>th</sup>, 2000 ending on January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2000.

I've attached a copy of the bids for the Cadmium Baghouse. ERI is the low bid at \$15,947.05. ERI was the contractor who performed our last abatement at the Converter Cottrells. So, they will not need to go to orientation unless they have employees who have not worked at the ASARCO facility previously. Their paper work for the Corporate Contractor Policy is current. Which also probably means their insurance should be in order for Reed. *INCLUDES CD OFFICE - REMOVAL OF WALL PANELING*

You will need to get with Environmental to order the roll-off boxes.

The following should be included as an addendum for the Contract (OLR) that you initiate for ERI.

1. Pre and Post biological monitoring shall be performed. This cost is included in the bid of \$15,947.05. Proof of laboratory testing or owner statement shall be presented at the start of the project. Proof of laboratory testing or owner statement shall be presented at the close of the project. Invoices shall not be approved without receipt of these statement items. Test are to include:  
Urine Arsenic                      Blood Lead  
Urine Beta 2                      Blood Cadmium  
Urine Cadmium  
Exposure panels should include specific gravity & creatinine.
2. Arsenic, lead, and cadmium compliance program(s) are to be submitted upon initiation of the project. ERI must provide training to all their employees based on the As, Cadmium, & Lead Standards. Documentation of said training shall be provided to ASARCO.
3. Asarco will provide water & electricity for the abatement project. Asarco assumes the cost associated with transporting the asbestos abatement debris. ERI must wrap and deposit the debris in roll-offs provided by ASARCO in compliance with State regulations.
4. Exposure monitoring (personnel air) for As, Cd, & Pb shall be provided by the contractor. In the event that ERI does not have the testing availability, Asarco will provide this service upon request.
5. In the event that the contractor does not meet the abatement end date of January 31<sup>st</sup>, 2000 contractor agrees to pay consultant costs for the additional days.
