Dear Bob:

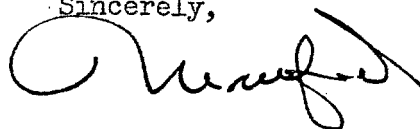
You were quite angelic to go to so much trouble in complying with my request for copies of your report for the Z66.1 boys.
