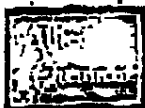

Dear Mr. Ehrlich:

This is in response to your May 28, 1974 letter requesting certain information with respect to Allied Chemical's manufacture and distribution of aerosol propellants which contain or contained vinyl chloride monomer (VCM).

1. Attached as Exhibit A is a list of customers to whom we have sold such propellants from 1969-1973.
2. In the same Exhibit we have indicated, where possible, the address of those customers and whether we believe they directly marketed (M), acted as fillers (F) or suppliers (S) of such propellants. Customers whose use of such propellant is undetermined have been so indicated (U).
3. From the records relating to fluorocarbon aerosols, we are not in a position to identify those customers who market consumer products subject to the Federal Hazardous Substances Act (Sections 2f, 2p, and 2q). I doubt seriously whether any records maintained by Allied Chemical, regardless of business area, would reveal such information, but such other records were not examined in this context.
4. Allied Chemical discontinued selling such propellants in May 1973. It is impossible to determine the specific date of our initial sales of such propellants. However, we began the manufacture and sale of such propellants in approximately 1961.

5. Since we have not sold such propellants for over a year, we are unable to determine any particular customer's inventory or inventory turnover rate.
6. VCM is also used as a feedstock for PVC resin, which in turn is used primarily for the production of plastic pipe. There are many possible consumer uses for PVC, including fence coatings, vinyl auto roofs, floor tiles and polishes. It can also be used in the production of various types of containers and in the extrusion of semi-rigid and rigid film for packaging purposes.
