Several days ago, I had a telephone call from Mr. E.E. Tibbetts of the Northern Indiana Public Service. This is the same gentleman who had called earlier regarding a transformer containing PYRANOL which had exploded. I described that incident in a memo of February 13, 1976.

Mr. Tibbetts requested that he be supplied with some toxicity data on PCBs and trichlorobenzene. We have complied with that request.

In the course of the conversation, he indicated that the two employees which had had the greatest exposure had recovered with no apparent residual injury.
