

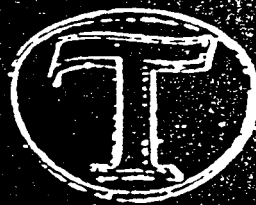

CLASSIFICATIONS AND LIMITS OF RISK, OCCUPATIONS, EXPOSURES AND HAZARDS

Any occupation, exposure or hazard not classified here will be rated by the Company upon receipt of full particulars.

Classifications of occupations, exposures and hazards are designated by the letters A, B, C, D*, D, E, F, G, H, I, J, K, L, M.

IMPORTANT

For classifications of Manufacturers see complete schedule under heading "Manufacturer."

Metal workers will be found under the "Metal Products Schedule."

Woodworkers will be found under the "Wood Products Schedule."

The maximum limits of single Principal Sum and single Weekly Indemnity for the various classifications given in this Manual are as follows:

These limits apply to all occupations in the respective classifications unless otherwise specified in the following occupational statement. Policies for amounts of Principal Sum and/or Weekly Indemnity cannot be issued without written approval of the Office.
