The following will in part confirm our phone conversation of August 12th.

The subject gypsum customer has obtained a plaster job on a school building addition at Clarksburg. The order covering the materials to be used will be prepared by your office at Akron. In this case we are to ship 16-1/10 tons of Lite-Mix for use over masonry. Also, 8 tons of Lite-Mix for use over Metal Lath.

In addition to the above we will ship 600 yards or the equivalent of Light Acoustical Plaster to be applied over a Lite-Mix base which is the area on which the metal lath is specified.

The balance of the job can be made up of regular Lite-Mix working out to a total of 30 tons.

It is our understanding that this order will be shipped at once. We further understand and have objected to this situation that the job is to be ready for occupancy on or about September 2nd, the General Contractor is also faced with a \$100.00 per day penalty clause if the job is not ready.

Following Mr. Watt's suggestion, Mr. Ted Tinney will arrange to come to Clarksburg from Akron to supervise the application of the Light Acoustical Plaster when the job is far enough along to arrive at a definite date. We also wish to add in talking to the Central Supply Company the fact they do not feel their plastering contractor or the individual who has this job, will be equipped with spray equipment for applying the final finish on the Light Acoustical Plaster. Maybe we could arrange, on this one job to have such equipment available either from Paoli or Akron in order to obtain the best possible result.

Through a copy of this letter we are asking our sales representative at Wheeling, Mr. FitzGerald, to keep us advised as the school job progresses so that there will be no delay on our part in the shipping and handling of the plastering materials.
