PREFACE

EX. 10710

When the decision was taken to prepare the present edition, invitations were extended to 257 libraries (including the 132 represented in the original edition) to contribute to the new edition. The response was very generous, although most of the libraries were unable, owing to staff shortages, to supply lists until a considerable period after the date of their agreement to cooperate.

As the preparation of the work progressed it became evident that, under existing and increasing difficulties of collation, compilation, and reproduction, the work could not be completed for some considerable time. Many of the libraries, by straining their resources, had sent in their lists promptly, and could not reasonably be expected to keep on sending entries once their lists were despatched. It therefore became necessary to fix a final date for inclusion of entries. Libraries were advised of this fact, and all entries for periodicals which commenced on or after January 1, 1946, were set aside as the nucleus of a proposed supplement. Those consulting this work and librarians generally are accordingly advised that they will not find in it any periodical which commenced after the date mentioned, though entries for all prior publications have been included, as far as possible, and brought up to date in the light of information received. For example, one will not find here any such entry as 'v.1(1946)+', but may find 'v.5 (1946)+', or a note such as '1943-47 all issued'.

SCOPE

It seems desirable, for those who have not a copy of the first edition to consult, to repeat the statement explaining the scope of the work. 'All periodicals of a scientific and technical nature, and publications issued serially by scientific and technical institutions and societies, have been included. After some hesitation it was decided to include periodicals dealing with Architecture, Horticulture, Photography, and Geography, but to exclude those dealing with Social Science, Education, History, Philology, Philosophy, and Sociology. Archaeology, though on the border line, has been omitted, but Ethnology included. These subjects are frequently to be found in the same periodical, and this accounts for the inclusion in the Catalogue of such publications as the Indian Antiquary, which is largely ethnological. Municipal journals, which deal partly with municipal engineering,

have been included, and the inclusion of automobile journals has necessitated that of cycling journals.' The Statement must now be modified in some respects.

(1) Parliamentary Papers are excluded from the present edition, as being only partly scientific in scope. As, however, these papers contain, e.g. those of the United States Congress, much valuable scientific material, the notification, 'also in Parliamentary Papers' is still retained. Workers who desire to follow up such intimation may do so by consulting the many entries in the first edition under the names of the issuing governments. Their scientific annual reports and other publications may be issued in this form only, so that the term 'also' may signify 'only'. Administration reports of smaller dependencies and mandated territories are sometimes the sole source of information on their scientific activities, and have been sparingly included.

(2) General indexes have been excluded.

(3) The following border-line cases are expressly included: Flock, Herd, and Stud books; Fire Prevention, Horology, Laundry, Lumber, Military and Naval periodicals, Motor Cycling, Printing, and Undertaking.

(4) Selected periodicals on Aborigines, Anti-noise, Birth-control, Blindness, and Home Security have been included.

(5) The following subjects, in addition to those mentioned above, have been considered unsuitable for inclusion: Actuarial Science, Anti-opium, Housing, Inebriety, Mental Deficiency, Mental Tests, Municipal Finances, Physical Fitness, Calendars, directories, and purely administrative reports of electric companies, gas companies, hospitals, and asylums, and similar bodies have also been excluded.

(6) An important decision to include (a) periodicals on statistical methods and (b) such periodicals on applied psychology as might reasonably be looked for in the medical section of a library classification was made after the preliminary work on the catalogue had begun. Under the circumstances, it was not possible to notify all libraries of this decision, but the leading libraries of the Commonwealth, and those likely to have collections dealing with these subjects, were asked to suggest a list of periodicals suitable for inclusion. The replies were carefully collated and a final list prepared. This list was then circulated to the selected libraries, which were asked to indicate their holdings. This procedure involved a material increase in the time of compilation but a
