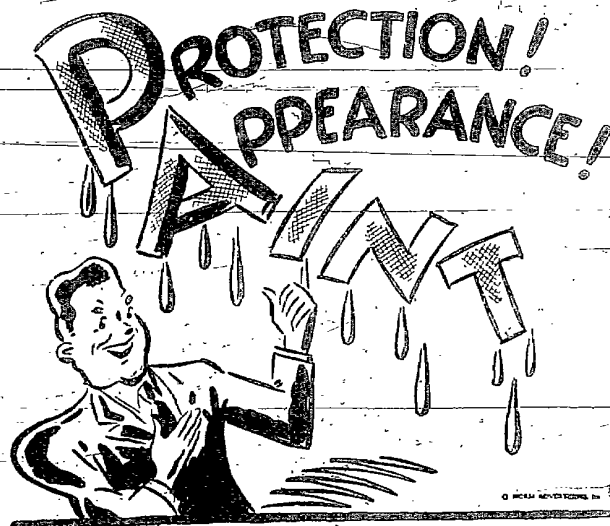
An important business meeting and luncheon of the Soroptimist club is scheduled for noon Wednesday at the Hotel San Carlos.

The bidding:
South West North East
1♣ Pass 2♣ Pass 4♣ Pass

West opened the deuce of trump, dummy winning with the nine. South saw that he was bound to lose the minor-suit Aces and one heart trick, but that was not all. If East got the lead before the hearts had been set up, he could lead a club, and West would get two club tricks and thus set the contract. The hearts had to be established in such a way, therefore, as to keep East out of the lead.

At the second trick declarer led a low heart from the dummy, hoping to finesse the nine and let West win the trick. But East quite properly put up the ten of hearts, and South had to win with the Ace to keep East from getting in at once.
