2 that location, would there, sir?

3 A No, sir.

4 Q And there wouldn't -- you don't have any
5 information here today from Owens-Corning's files to
6 indicate that McCormick Asbestos Insulation Company
7 was not a distributor or a user of Kaylo product at
8 that location, do you, sir?

9 A No, I wouldn't know.

10 Q And in the early 1960s, at the Hamilton
11 Middle School or at the Northern High School, the
12 Kaylo that your company made and distributed did not
13 have a label on it at that time; is that correct,
14 sir?

15 A Yes, that is correct.

16 Q Okay.

17 Now, I take it that you told us that the
18 label initially went on in around Christmas of 1966;
19 is that right?

20 A Yes, we started stamping the cartons at that
21 point.
