1932 United States Revolver Association
Matches Result in Many U. S. Victories

Shooters of U. S. Ammunition came well to the fore in the 1932 matches of the United States Revolver Association . . . the performances of Dr. I. R. Calkins and Joseph F. Rivers, winners of three national events, being particularly outstanding. Dr. Calkins not only won the National Championship for his Grand Aggregate score and finished first in the National Match M, but he won Match M and Match O in the Massachusetts Shoot. Joseph F. Rivers, who won the National Match O (Pocket Revolver), also finished first in Matches M, N and O in the Connecticut State events. The National and State Championship events in which shooters of U.
