

1 Q Approximately when did you first start
2 reviewing meso cases?

3 A When I first started looking was when I was
4 a resident pathologist.

5 Q That was a number of years ago?

6 A Many years ago.

7 Q I think you also testified that you have
8 seen approximately 90 mesothelioma cases in your
9 hometown or local?

10 A That would be about what I have seen since I
11 have been there, yes.

12 Q Can you estimate for the jury approximately
13 how many of the 3,000 mesothelioma cases you have seen
14 came to you as a result of the, I guess, referral from
15 lawyers?

16 A I can estimate that. I would say probably
17 in a neighborhood of 100 a year, and I have been doing
18 this from 1986, 10 years, so probably about 1,000.

19 Q Two thousand would have been referred to you
20 by other pathologists or would have come to you in
21 your normal practice?
